Our headliner this year is the up and coming troubadour, Jack Klatt and his band, The Cat Swingers. With rollicking finger-picked guitar and soulful vocals, these boys flawlessly perform a mixture of blues and jazz standards and Jack's original compositions.

Wrapping up the festival, as always, is the Sunday morning gospel sing, down by the Kickapoo River at 11 o'clock.
